Continuing our commitment to you in bringing the highest quality and range of arts and entertainment to North Powys, I hope that you enjoy looking through this Spring Season brochure. There is the usual mix of dance, music, comedy and quality children's entertainment – look out for **Cathy Shipton** (TV's Duffy from Casualty) performing in **Soldiers Wives**, the world renowned vocal skills brought to you from **Ruby Turner** and the comedic chaos that **Lee Hurst** brings to our stage. The Arts Council of Wales has accepted the registration of the project and has initially allocated £3million towards the build costs. This is nearly half the total amount of the entire project. We have been considering the social impact of this development on our communities and can clearly see the vision in which Hafren can become the focus of all arts and creative projects in the area. We have also been considering the environmental impact of such a facility. We are investigating recently developed sustainable technologies. We are impressed with the "Passivhaus" rigorous energy standard that achieves significant reduction in energy consumption, over and above current UK building regulations. Passivhaus is essentially all about achieving energy reduction by good design, rather than relying on technical fixes or add-on technologies. This is robust and long lasting. We are very keen to utilise locally sourced materials to create a building that is light and airy, modern and fit for purpose. We know where we want to be in the future and more importantly why. If you would like the opportunity to discuss your ideas and thoughts then please feel free to get in touch with us.

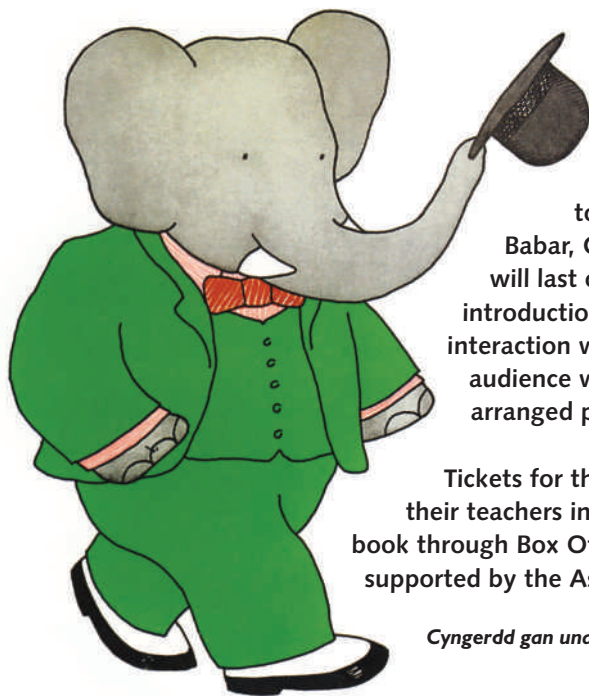

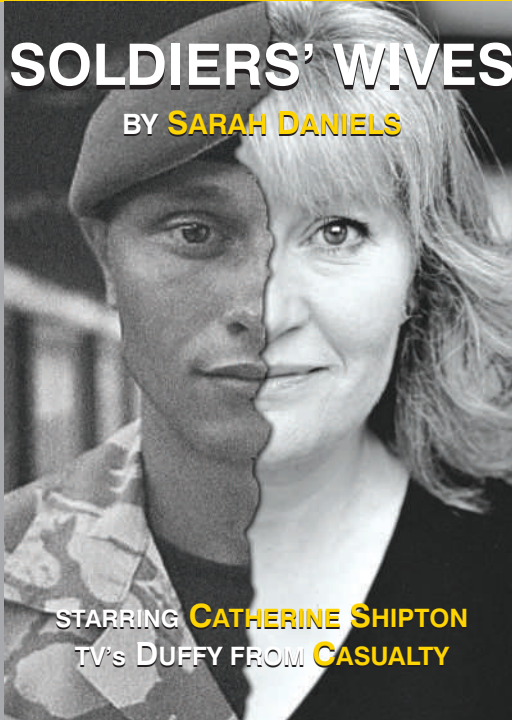

Lee Hurst **Too scared to leave the house**

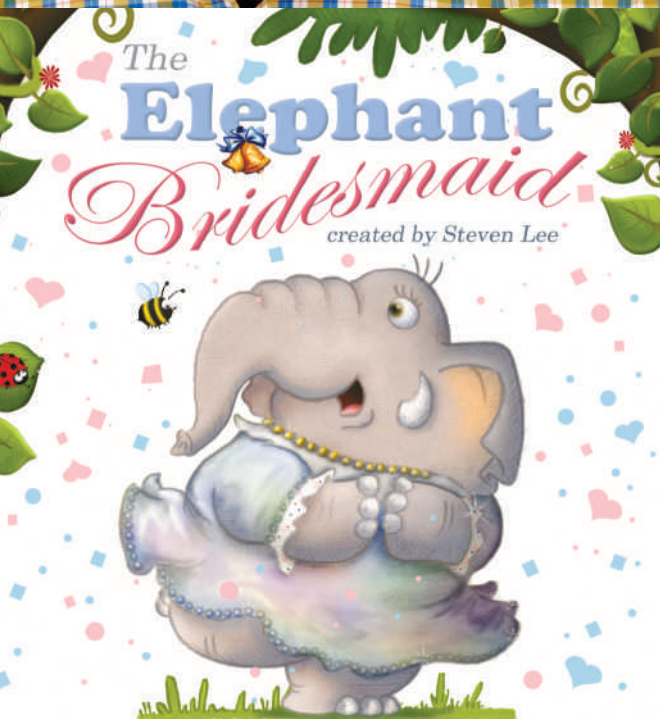
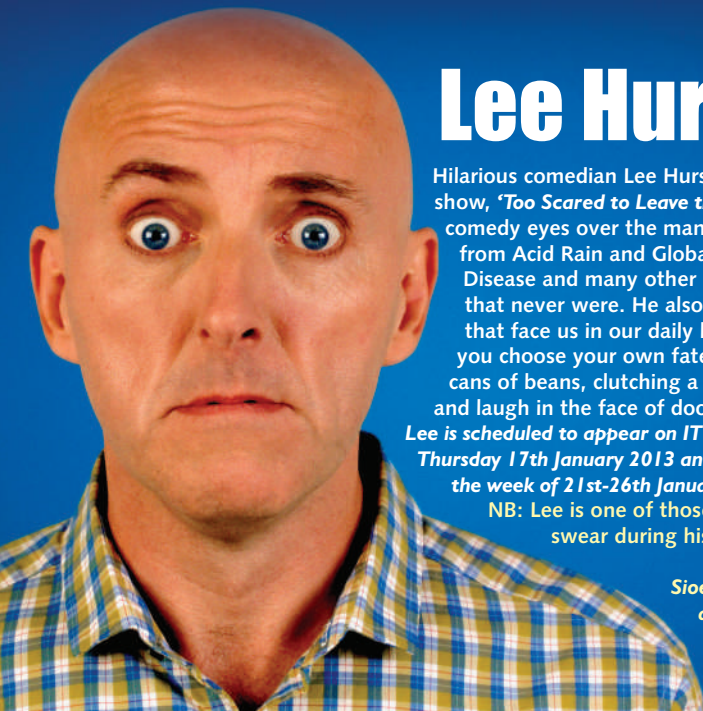

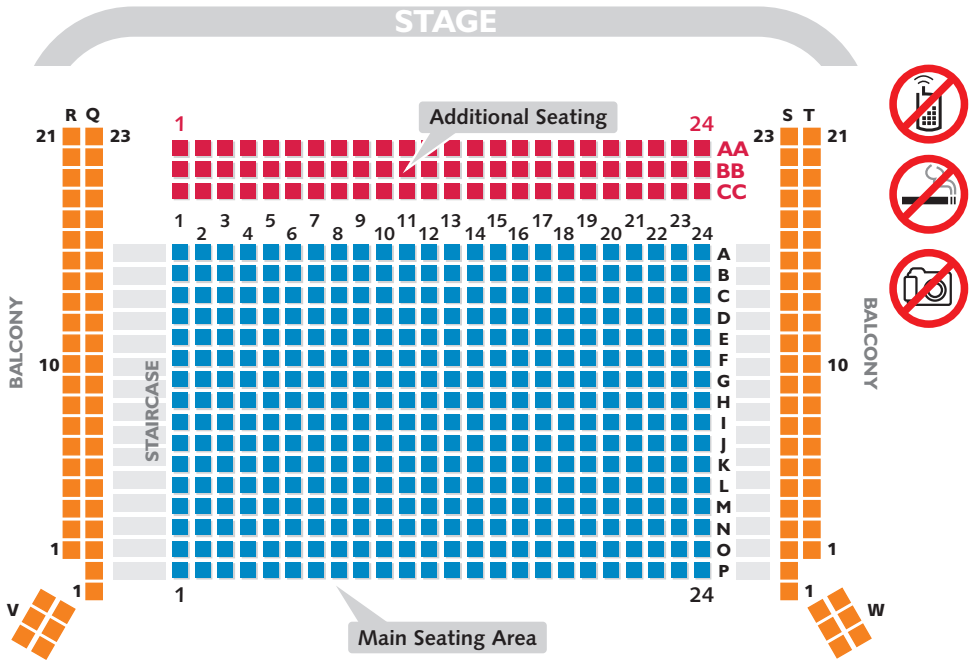


ANTHONY BUTTERFIELD
